## No Fear Scripture Cards

"For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strongholds." - 2 Corinthians 10:4 KJV

In the battle to overcome fear, we must use the weapons God has given us, which are prayer and his Word. These verses are those that speak specifically to God's deliverance and faithfulness. Memorize these verses and every time a fearful thought or anxiety arises, counter it by speaking a verse out loud.

Tips for Memorization.

While every person can memorize information, we each process that information differently. Here are a few ways to memorize information:

- Repetition: This is primarily the way I memorize Scripture. I will take a verse and read it 10 times outload. Then I will repeat it 5 times, without reading it. If i can say it perfectly, I will go on to the next verse
- Writing the first letter of each word in the verse on a piece of paper. Read through the verse outloud 5 to 10 times, then say the verse outloud 5 times looking only at the paper with the letters. For exacmple, the verse above would be "f t w o o w a n c b m t g t t p d o s": Rather than memorizing individual verses. I recently began working on memorizing a book of the Bible and this method has been very effective for me. I've found that I do not need as much initial repetition to learn the passage.
- Mnemonics: Strategies using forms of mnemonics work well for some people. This could be associating a verse with music, a picture, or drawing a diagram that illustrates the verse in your mind. Each of the pictures were chosen for the cards because they either illustrate what the verse is saying, or evoke the feeling of the verse. I have found working with third graders, that sometimes it is not just a picture association that helps them memorize, but their own picture.

These are just a few strategies. Find what works best for you. The more Scripture you have on tap, the more you make God's Word a part of yourself, the more you will find the Holy Spirit renewing your thoughts and transforming your mind. The more you memorize, the easier the memorization will become.
